LOCATION: Situated just 20 miles north of San Diego International Airport, The Grand Golf Club is ideally located in coastal North San Diego County, east of the I-5 in Del Mar near the La Jolla-Rancho Santa Fe-Del Mar triangle.

HISTORY: San Diego's only Tom Fazio-designed course originally opened in 1999 as part of the Meadows Del Mar, a private residential community of 134 home sites. In 2003, Manchester Grand Resorts purchased the land – including the golf course, clubhouse and a parcel zoned for hotel development. The course was renamed The Grand Golf Club, and the extensively renovated and expanded clubhouse was opened in September 2006.

GOLF COURSE OVERVIEW:

With spectacular fairways that wind throughout the scenic valleys of the beautiful Los Peñasquitos Canyon Preserve, the private rolling greens of The Grand Golf Club are the centerpiece of The Grand Del Mar luxury resort.

This championship-quality course deftly captures the essence of Southern California's coastal environs with its varying elevation, diversity of its bunkering, and impeccable manicured fairways and greens.

Melding extreme playability with stunning natural beauty, the 18-hole, par-72 course features 7,160 yards spread over a lush 380 acres. Tee locations span from 5,230 to 7,160 yards in length, accommodating all levels of play.

COURSE ENHANCEMENTS:

Recent course improvements include the redesign of the 16th hole from a par-4 into a par-5 and it was lengthened by 115 yards. Other additions: a cascading \$1 million water feature with a trickling stream and an 18-foot waterfall; a short game practice area featuring a chipping green and sand bunkers; a second 4,200-square-foot putting green for a total of three short game areas; a 5,000-square-foot practice tee on the back-side of the practice range; state-of-the-art laser measuring devices and new bunker sand (Palm Springs 75/25 marble crush mix).

Adding to its lush playability, 250 mature trees have recently been planted, vibrant new florals incorporated and more than 1.5 million feet of fresh sod installed. In addition, the course is overseeded each fall to provide optimum playing conditions throughout the winter.

DIRECTOR OF GOLF:

Shawn G. Cox – A member of the Professional Golfers Association of America (PGA), Cox completed the PGA's specialty certification in instruction in 2005, and is the first person in Southern California to be certified through this program. He is known for using a physical screening process to identify and isolate physical limitations and prescribes customized conditioning for each of his students, among them current LPGA and PGA players. As testament to his teaching skills, he received *Golf Digest's* Best State Instructor Award. He previously served as assistant head golf professional at La Jolla Country Club and at Torrey Pines Municipal Golf Course, where he founded the Junior Golf Club.

COURSE DESIGNER:

With 10 courses on "America's 100 Greatest" listing by *Golf Digest*, Tom Fazio is America's most acclaimed golf architect. The Grand Golf Club is the only Fazio-designed course in San Diego.

GREEN FEES:

Customary: Monday through Thursday, \$195; Friday through Sunday, \$215
Twilight: Daily, \$125
Replay (second round on the same day): \$85 daily
Youths: Complimentary for children ages 12 and under accompanied by an adult; half-price for ages 13–17

AMENITIES:

Fees include use of state-of-the-art carts – stocked with complimentary beverages and refreshments – equipped with Laser Link range finders for exact yardage to each hole.

Also offered: complimentary yardage books, a launch monitor to measure balls in flight and professional club fittings using the Zelosity PureLaunch – the latest in radar technology. Guests can also test drive the newest and hottest equipment from every major manufacturer on the market.

RENTALS:

Top-of-the-line Callaway Clubs, with a pouch of 6 Callaway premium balls, are available for rent.

FORE CADDIE PROGRAM:

The Grand Golf Club's fore caddie program reinstitutes a longstanding tradition no longer found at many courses. An experienced caddie will guide and assist resort guests – enhancing the golf experience by providing course strategy, measuring distances, filling divots, raking bunkers, finding errant shots and ensuring all other needs are met.

INSTRUCTION:

The Grand Golf Club comprehensive instruction program provides guests with the ultimate golf learning experience – offering a unique combination of industry expertise, cutting edge technology and world-class facilities. State-of-the-art high definition video equipment is offered for all golf instruction, which includes one- and two-hour lessons, full- and half-day programs and lessons for juniors. Prices range from \$175 to \$2,400, with instruction highlights, including:

- **One-Hour Lesson.** Discover all of the nuances of your swing using technologically advanced digital video equipment. You'll develop a confidence in your swing that translates to an enhanced learning experience. Includes a take-home CD of the lesson. \$175 for adults; \$125 for juniors.
- **90-Minute Putting Evaluation.** Led by one of The Grand Golf Club's instructors, fine tune your game on the greens with a complete putting evaluation, featuring a SAM-Putting Stroke Analysis, used by the top players on the PGA, LPGA and Champions tours. The intelligent SAM PuttWare automatically evaluates the putting strokes, calculates all relevant parameters – e.g. rotation, acceleration, swing duration or impact – and graphically displays the results, revealing precise information on how to improve your game and tailor individual training strategies. \$275
- **Full-Day Program.** Participants start with a valuable on-course evaluation, and then practice their full swing and short game on the practice area – receiving a SAM-Putting Stroke Analysis and evaluation of technique and movement skills. The day culminates with a round on the golf course to apply improved techniques. \$1,000
- **Customized Golf Fitness Screening.** Utilizing the Titleist Performance Institute screening process, participants undergo a comprehensive golf and physical evaluation with a battery of tests typically reserved for the top golfers in the world. Resort pros isolate physical limitations, correlate these findings to swing technique and prescribe a custom conditioning program. This assessment of the entire body and swing will allow golfers to maximize their workout and optimize performance on the course. \$500
- **Three-Hour “Train Like the Pros” Session.** Revealing precise information on how to improve a player's game and tailor individual training strategies, this program includes a full swing video lesson, as well as a SAM-Putting Stroke Analysis, a take-home CD of the lesson and a SAM PuttLab extended report. \$500
- **The “On-Course” Experience.** From improving shot skills to more practical aspects of the game such as rules, etiquette and controlling a ball's flight, there is nothing like on-course instruction and situational practice to test every aspect of the game. In addition to its regular programs, The Grand Golf Club features San Diego's first Dave Pelz Scoring Game School. Designed for golfers seriously focused on honing their short game skills, this world-renowned program applies a practical, scientific – and totally unique – approach to golf instruction. The resort will offer a special rate of \$335 per night for students that includes accommodations, breakfast for two daily and complimentary valet parking. PACKAGES:

The resort offers an array of “stay and play” options, among them:

The Grand Golf Getaway – Golfers save up to \$710 when playing 45 holes. This popular package includes one night's accommodations, unlimited golf for two players, full breakfast for two daily, 20% discount on retail purchases and complimentary overnight valet parking. Rates from \$670

CLUBHOUSE:

A distinct, exotic Mediterranean motif prevails at the luxuriously appointed 50,000-square-foot Clubhouse. The extensively remodeled facility re-opened September 2006 and now incorporates amenities such as: Addison, the resort's Five Diamond, Five-Star signature restaurant; The Clubhouse Grill serving breakfast and lunch; generous meeting space and numerous patios; members-only locker rooms complete with spa treatment rooms, sauna, steam and whirlpool facilities; and a golf shop.

Height of Cut: 1/8 inch, year-round
Conditions: 10/11 Stimpmeter reading year-round

Fairways

Grass Variety: 419 Bermudagrass
Height of Cut: 1/3 inch, year-round
Conditions: Firm and fast with tight lies

Roughs

Grass Variety: Bullseye Bermudagrass
Height of Cut: 1 1/2 inches, year-round
Conditions: Dense grass that provides upright lies and prevents the ball from burying

Tees

Grass Variety: 328 Bermudagrass overseeded with Ryegrass
Height of Cut: 1/3 inch, year-round
Conditions: Level-teeing surfaces, tight lies

CLIMATE: With an average of over 300 days of sunshine a year, the golfing climate here is ideal. The temperature range is:

Spring:	High 70°F	Low 53°F
Summer:	High 78°F	Low 62°F
Fall:	High 77°F	Low 54°F
Winter:	High 67°F	Low 49°F
